

Say Something

Snitching

An **Upstander** is someone who notices when things are not right and does something to help. Upstanders work to include everyone and to keep everyone safe.




Trusted Adult

A **warning sign** is a behavior that shows someone may be planning to hurt themselves or others.




Threat


A **threat** is when a person says that they DO plan to harm themselves or others.


